#### Bird Photography – Beyond the Basics 9:00 AM to 10:30 AM (Central time)

Creating photographs of the birds of our world is a fun and challenging pursuit. In this course, we will go beyond the basics, learning tips and tricks to take your bird photography to the next level. Attendees will learn how to properly use fill-flash, how to use many different types of blinds, as well as how to build a backyard bird photography studio. Participants will learn why you don't need a \$12,000 lens to photograph of a bird.

#### Landscape – Landscape Photography by Steve Gettle 11:00 AM to 12:30 PM (Central Time)
