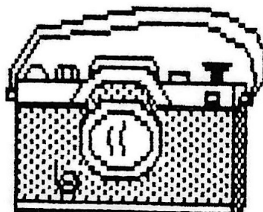

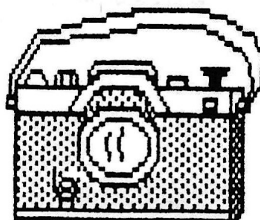

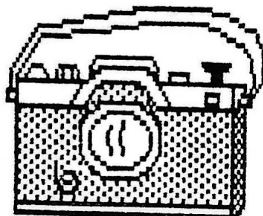

Have you paid your dues? After the December meeting, we will be updating our mailing list. Members who have not rejoined will be removed.

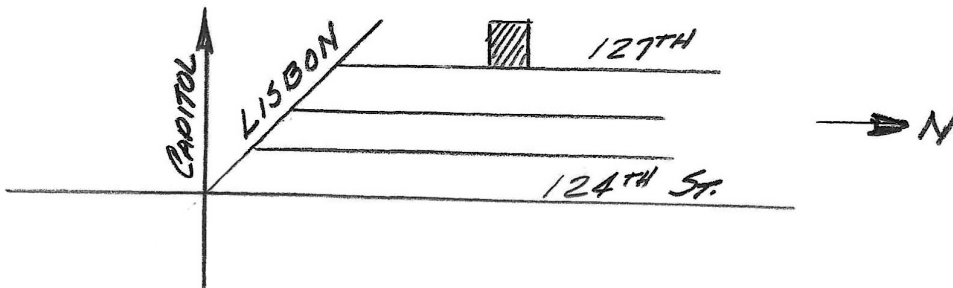

**Photo Tip on Using an Exposure Meter:** Don't include a bright light source when making a meter reading. The light will fool your meter into recommending underexposure. Make meter readings close to your subject. With an automatic camera, get as close as possible to your subject to take the picture.

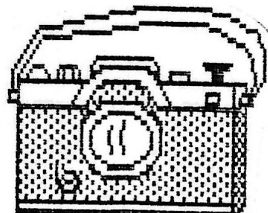

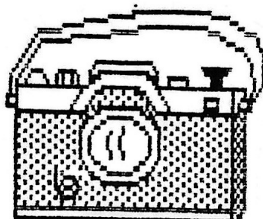
