The Menomonee Falls Camera Club will meet on Tuesday, October 1st at 7:15 p.m. in the Community Room of Menomonee Falls North Middle School. Prospective new members and guests are welcome.

Our president will introduce, "Merit Award Book I" (Kodak Self Teaching Guide to Basic Photography) and plans which will lead us into our own "Merit Award Book II" program. Be there!

The workshop program will be TABLETOP PHOTOGRAPHY. A video on the subject may be shown first. There will be at least two electronic flash setups and one tungsten lighting setup. Subject material will be musical instruments as well as memorabilia. Come equipped with cameras, medium telephoto lenses in the 75mm to 135mm range and tripods. Use daylight film (slide or negative) with the electronic flash setups. For the tungsten setup (a) bring tungsten film (b) use an 80B color correction filter with your daylight film (but be prepared for the loss of two f-stops (c) load a second camera with tungsten film.

IMPORTANT: We will have a repeat musical instrument set up. If you have an instrument, please bring it. Bring at least one memorabilia item, something antique or old to fit into a tabletop/still life arrangement: jewelry, glassware, books, photos, eyeglasses, knickknacks, utensils, etc. Or bring photographic props such as baskets, dry flowers, or anything else with interesting shape, design, and texture for tabletop arrangements.

The workshop will afford you creative challenges and another opportunity to enter material in the coming WACCO competitions.

The Menomonee Falls Camera Club will meet on Tuesday, November 5th at 7:15 p.m. in the Community Room of Menomonee Falls North Middle School. Prospective new members and guests are welcome.

Please bring a sampling of your slides and prints from the October Tabletop Workshop. Our thanks to Jeff and Jon for their lighting setups. For your tabletop shots, do you know what camera, film, lenses, filters, f-stops and lighting you used? For future reference, a highly recommended discipline is to maintain a notebook for all your photographic endeavors.

Our November meeting will feature equipment and techniques for COPYING OLD FAMILY PHOTOGRAPHS. Technical considerations will include flat, even lighting, perfect parallelism between the film plane and the print and stability of both the camera and the copy platform. You are invited to bring at least one old family photo you wish to have copied. A preferred size for this program is 8"x10". Other sizes may be copied as time permits to make copy adjustments. Film will be furnished by the Club and processed by Jeff Klug. The copy prints will be given to you at the December meeting.

Copying old prints may be only the first step to achieving acceptable copies, especially when originals are cracked, faded, scratched or even badly damaged. Some retouching techniques may be explained but the procedures will not be part of the session. However, the copying procedures demonstrated may motivate some of you to create a family tree photo album or a wall display of family pictures.

Many newer 35mm cameras need a Circular Polarizer instead of the normal (linear) polarizer. Why? because some 35mm cameras now use beam splitters as part of their internal metering system. These meters already polarize light; therefore, the light from a normal (linear) polarizing filter will cause a reduction in light and thus an inaccurate exposure. This can be corrected by using a Circular Polarizer.

The Menomonee Falls Camera Club will meet on Tuesday, December 3rd at 7:15 p.m. in the Community Room of Menomonee Falls North Middle School. After a brief business meeting, club members will venture out to photograph "Mainstreet, Menomonee Falls!" and return after about an hour to the Community Room for refreshments and fellowship.

Expect interesting results from the color discrepancies of different artificial light sources as you photograph outdoor street scenes at night with existing light. The illumination from windows, street lights and car lights may be bright enough to take hand-held pictures on high-speed film. But most often night photography requires exposures of from 1/30 second to a full second or so at a wide open aperture, making a tripod necessary. The meters on most cameras should respond accurately, but it is advisable to bracket. You may elect to use Ektachrome 160 slide film (tungsten) or you may prefer high speed negative films with an ISO of 400 to 1000.

The copy prints of Old Family Photographs taken at the November meeting will be handed out. Thanks to Jeff Klug and Jon Moscicki for setting up their equipment and to Jeff for processing the film.
