After a brief business meeting, venture out to photograph the street scenes and night lights of Menomonee Falls, try Main Street or one of the shopping malls; then return to the Community Room for fellowship and refreshments... And, if it fits your budget, talents, or resources, additional donations of goodies for the evening will be appreciated.

The Joy of Photography says, "Buildings and other structures are often magically transformed when they are illuminated at night. ...lighted structures will take on the color characteristics of the artificial light being used. When daylight-balanced film is used to record night scenes, structures lighted by incandescent light sources appear warmer and more golden... whereas ones lit by fluorescent and other less common sources... take on an eerie green cast." Use a Tripod! make exposures at 1/30 second to a full second or so at a wide open aperture. Exposure meters on most cameras should respond accurately. If in doubt, bracket!

Do something just for the pun of it! Lynn Buttenhof gave us a sampling of what this is all about and gave us the handout, "Photography Just Phor Phun!" Everyone can enter the February contest, a contest employing creativity and imagination, with simple photographic skills and props. Three excellent prizes will be awarded for: 1) Best portrayal of a pun involving either a photographic term or a photographic item 2) Best portrayal of either "let your creative juices flow" or "let your hair down", and 3) Best of Show -- (this excludes winners from the other categories). **BLACKLIGHT PHOTOGRAPHY!** One visible effect of ultraviolet radiation is its ability to make certain materials fluoresce -- to produce light waves that make them seem to glow in the dark. The technique of photographing this phenomenon, known as fluorescent or blacklight photography, is relatively simple and can yield eerie yet beautiful results.

When exposed to a strong ultraviolet source such as a common blacklight fluorescent tube, many everyday objects glow. Among them are plastics, fabrics, certain cosmetics, art and craft store fluorescent inks, paints, crayons, and papers that you can apply to objects to make them glow. The dimness of light coming from a fluorescing object makes it best to use a high-speed daylight-balanced film, such as ASA 400 for prints or a chrome ASA 400 film for slides. A UV filter may enhance your results as well.

Even with fast film, plan on using a tripod, cable release and a relatively long exposure and possibly experiment or bracket exposures because the meter on most cameras is not sensitive enough to determine accurate exposure for fluorescence. However, expect to see dazzling results displayed at our next meeting.

All in attendance at the PUNography contest were challenged but not outwitted as they first identified and then voted on the photographic creativity of several club members. Prizes went to Roger Crill, Bob Schwan and Jaye Theurich.
